## MBA ADMISSION CRITERIA

The Evening Graduate Programs, at California State University Northridge, look for students who show a high promise of success both in the program and in their future career endeavors. Ideal applicants meet the following criteria:

- o A bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university and a 3.0 GPA in the last 60 semester units (90 quarter units) are required.
- o Professional work experience of two years is required; however three to five years is preferable.
- o GMAT scores must be in the 50th percentile or higher on all sections.
- o Foreign applicants must take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) examination. Applicants must score a minimum of 213 (computer based scale).

Applications are first evaluated by the university admissions office. If it is determined that the applicant meets the university's admission requirements, then the application materials are forwarded to the Graduate Programs office for evaluation.
