



- Complete and submit an application for admission (on-line www.csumentor.edu) to the campus Office of Admissions and Records (by May 1 for fall admission and October 1 for spring admission). Be sure to include the \$55 application fee.
- Have all official transcripts mailed to CSUN's Office of Admissions and Records. Transcripts will be used to calculate grade point average and determine foundation course requirements upon admission (18111 Nordhoff St. Northridge, CA 91330-8207).
- Submit a current resume directly to our office (via fax, in person, email or US mail).
- Complete the GMAT exam (by May 31 for fall admission and October 30 for spring admission) and have your official score report sent to CSUN.
- Submit a Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score of at least 213 (computer based scale) to the Office of Admissions and Records, if you are an international applicant.

Admission to the MBA program is a two-step process. You must first meet the University admission requirements (a completed bachelor's degree and a minimum 2.5 GPA in your last 60 semester units of coursework). Once you have met the University admission requirements, your application materials will be forwarded to the College of Business and Economics (COBAE) Graduate Office for evaluation.
